

In Memory of Joe Jamison Bursary

One-time award: June 2023

Bursary total: \$1500 towards post-secondary studies

Criteria:

- Awarded to a student with financial need who consistently demonstrates kindness and citizenship in the school community
- Preference will be given to applicants actively participating in areas of interest or passion
- Students need to confirm enrolment in a post-secondary program, whereby they are pursuing a career of service in some form.

Eligibility Requirements:

- must be attending one of the following schools: KSS, MBSS, OKM, GESS, RSS, CPS, e-school
- must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or refugee
- must be in grade 12 and graduating for the first time in June 2023
- must be a full-time student (completing a minimum of 6 courses during their gr. 12 school year)
- must be attending an accredited post-secondary institution full time in September 2023
- must demonstrate financial need

1. Attach verification from the Post-secondary institution you will attend showing you have been accepted and indicating which program of study you plan to follow. This could be a print out of an email from the institution, or a copy of a letter you received from the post-secondary institution.
2. Attach two reference letters in sealed and signed envelopes (signature across seal).
 - a. A letter from a school personnel (teacher or administrator) detailing your demonstrated kindness and citizenship in school.
 - b. A letter addressing your involvement in your interest/passion area(s) or employment. This could be from a school personnel (separate and different from other letter) or from a community person, employer, coach, etc.

Completed applications (PART A form, PART B responses, & PART C attachments) must be received at the COTA office on or before 4:30pm, June 30, 2023.
